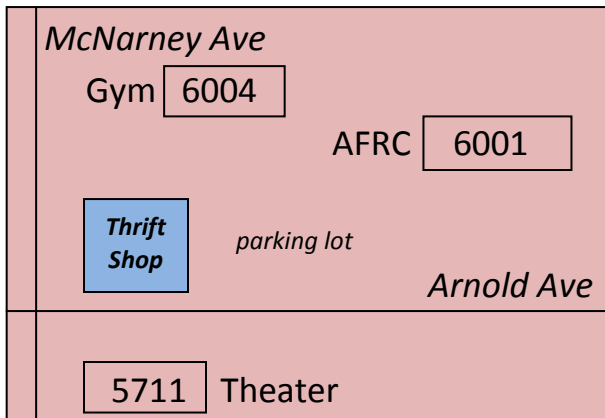

Consignor Guidelines

Consignors are limited to 20 items per family, per business day. Only 10 of the 20 items may be clothing.

You decide the price on your items

Items must be priced in increments of .00, .30, .50, .80 on the dollar.

Minimum price per item is \$1.30

Consignor retains 70% of the sales price. 30% is retained by the Thrift Shop.

You can reduce the price on any of your items once during the contract period.

Merchandise not sold or reclaimed by the expiration date will become the property of the Tinker OSC Thrift Shop.

All electrical items must be in good working order and will be tested.

Please call to verify available space before bring large item such as furniture.

The Thrift Shop reserves the right to refuse any item brought in for consignment.

To save time you may want to “blind tag” your items at home. Use the sample below as a reference:

A1234
6/15/1

“A” represents the first initial of you last name; 1234 represents you consignors identification number; 6/15 represents the date you consign your item; “1” identifies the item number on your contract.

Contracts can be purchase for .50 cents and include stickers for blind tags.

Checks for items sold are issued by the 2nd Tuesday of the month following the sales.

Consigned items may be withdrawn at any time before the expiration of the contract by paying a withdrawal fee. The fee is based on the sale price of the item. The minimum fee is .30 cents per item. The maximum fee is \$5.00 per item.
